Matthew 3:1-2 (NIV)

In those days John the Baptist came, preaching in the wilderness of Judea and saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near."

Matthew 4:17 (NIV)

From that time on (after hearing that John had been put in prison) Jesus began to preach, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near."

Matthew 5:3,10 (NIV)

Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

We have been asked to wait; Jesus' disciples were asked to wait.

Acts 1:1-3

In my former book, Theophilus, I wrote about all that Jesus began to do and to teach until the day he was taken up to heaven, after giving instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles he had chosen.

Acts 1:1-3

After his suffering, he presented himself to them and gave many convincing proofs that he was alive. He appeared to them over a period of forty days and spoke about the kingdom of God.
