Planning ahead for reopening: Physical indoor church services will be allowed to resume during Phase 2, with 25% of building capacity allowed.

Based on the IBC, occupancy capacity for Skykomish Community Church sanctuary would be 141 individuals (assuming 7sq.ft./ person) 25% of that amount would mean we can have 35 individuals during Phase 2. If for any reason we go over that amount, we could open the north windows and add three more family units to the ramp.

Preparing the pews for social distancing in anticipation of Phase 2 reopening!


