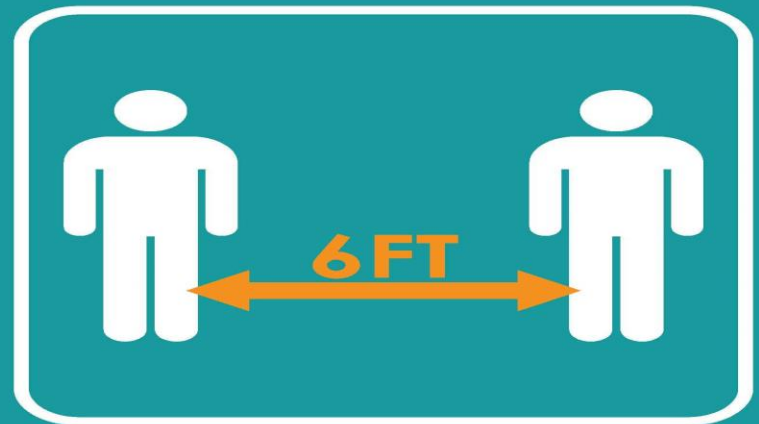

Today's Text: Ephesians 5:22 (NIV)

For the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the head of the church, his body, of which he is the Savior.

Notes on “Body of Christ” (modified from
Wikipedia article)

The Body of Christ is used to collectively describe believers in Christ. Christians are members of the universal body of Christ not because of identification with the institution of the Church, but through identification with Christ directly through faith.
