However..."

It likewise applies to husband/wife relationships. In fact, the previous teachings in Ephesians are also relevant.

- •4:1 > live a life worthy of the calling you received.
- •4:2 >Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love.
- •4:3 > Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.

- •4:12b-13 >so that the body of Christ may be built up until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.
- •4:15 >speaking the truth in love

•4:16 > From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work.

- •4:22 >You were taught... to put off your old self
- •4:23 >to be made new in the attitude of your minds
- •4:24 >to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.

- •4:25 > each of you must put off falsehood and speak truthfully to your neighbor (husband/wife), for we are all members of one body.
- •4:26-27 > In your anger do not sin: Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, and do not give the devil a foothold.

- •4:29 > Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen.
- •4:31 >Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice.

- •4:32 >Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.
- •5:1 >Follow God's example
- •5:2 >walk in the way of love
- •5:3 >among you there must not be even a hint of sexual immorality

- •5:3 > there must not be even a hint of any kind of impurity, or of greed, because these are improper for God's holy people.
- •5:4 > Nor should there be obscenity, foolish talk or coarse joking, which are out of place, but rather thanksgiving.

Ephesians 5:21-33 (NIV)

Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.

Wives, submit yourselves to your own husbands as you do to the Lord. For the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the head of the church, his body, of which he is the Savior.

Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit to their husbands in everything.

Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word, and to

present her to himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless. In the same way, husbands ought to love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself. After all, no one ever hated their own body, but they feed and
