 - Romans 9:17 "For Scripture says to Pharaoh: 'I raised you up for this very purpose, that I might display my power in you and that my name might be proclaimed in all the earth.'"
 - Romans 13:1 "Let everyone be subject to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except that which God has established. The authorities that exist have been established by God."

Are we against God's Chosen Instruments?

- Should we be against 'evil leaders'?
 - Daniel 2:20-21 "Praise be to the name of God for ever and ever; wisdom and power are his. He changes times and seasons; he deposes kings and raises up others. He gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to the discerning."
 - Proverbs 16:4 "The LORD works out everything to its proper end—even the wicked for a day of disaster."

Are we against God's Chosen Instruments?

- Should we be against 'evil leaders'?
 - John 19:11 "Jesus answered, 'You (Pilot) would have no power over me if it were not given to you from above. Therefore the one who handed me over to you is guilty of a greater sin.'"
 - Habakkuk 1:6 (God answering Habakkuk) "I am raising up the Babylonians, that ruthless and impetuous people, who sweep across the whole earth to seize dwellings not their own."
