




Review: Stand firm then, with the breastplate of righteousness in place,

Review: Stand firm then, with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel.



Helmet of Salvation





- The helmet protected the head
- It was made from thick leather inside and metal outside
- · It protected the back of the neck
- It protected the face so the soldier could keep his eyes on the goal









And the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God



- The sword was short, lightweight, and wellbalanced
- Used for close contact



Jesus <u>IS</u> the Armor

- Belt of Truth; John 14:6 says Jesus is the truth.
- Breastplate of Righteousness; 2 Corinthians 5:21 says that "in him we might become the righteousness of God."
- Gospel shoes fit with the Readiness which comes from the Gospel of peace; Ephesians 2:14 says Jesus himself is our peace. The Gospel is Jesus Christ with all the blessings contained in him.

Jesus <u>IS</u> the Armor

- The Shield of Faith; His faithfulness makes possible our faith. Galatians 2:20 says "I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.
- The Helmet of Salvation; In Luke 2:30, when Simeon saw Jesus in the temple he says that he has seen the Lord's Salvation.
- The Sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God; John 1:1, 14, states that Jesus is the Word.

Ephesians 6:18a Pray Prayers

Today's Text: Ephesians 6:18a (NIV)

And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests.

Philippians 4:6 (NIV)

Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.

Romans 8:26-28 (NIV)

In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans. And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for God's people

Romans 8:26-28 (NIV)

in accordance with the will of God. And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.

And when you pray, do not be like the hypocrites, for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the street corners to be seen by others. Truly I tell you, they have received their reward in full.

But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father, who is unseen. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.

And when you pray, do not keep on babbling like pagans, for they think they will be heard because of their many words. Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him.

This, then, is how you should pray: "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.

And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one."

For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive others their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins.

Colossians 4:2 (NIV)

Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful.

Luke 21:36 (NIV)

Be always on the watch, and pray that you may be able to escape all that is about to happen, and that you may be able to stand before the Son of Man.

Luke 18:1 (NIV)

Then Jesus told his disciples a parable to show them that they should always pray and not give up.

(The Parable of the Persistent Widow) "And will not God bring about justice for his chosen ones, who cry out to him day and night?"
