Today's Text: Romans 12:17 (NIV)

- Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everyone.
- (ESV) Repay no one evil for evil, but give thought to do what is honorable in the sight of all.

Ephesians 6:11-12 (NIV)

Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.

Romans 12:9 (NIV)

Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good.

1 Thessalonians 5:15 (NIV)

Make sure that nobody pays back wrong for wrong, but always strive to do what is good for each other and for everyone else.

Mark 7:20-23 (NIV)

He went on: "What comes out of a person is what defiles them. For it is from within, out of a person's heart, that evil thoughts come sexual immorality, theft, murder, adultery, greed, malice, deceit, lewdness, envy, slander, arrogance and folly. All these evils come from inside and defile a person."

Proverbs 20:22 (NIV)
