

Building Up North River Community Church On January 6th 2022, the North River began to rise with the snow melt and rain. At dinnertime, I (Travis) got an email from an Elder of the church who lives upriver. He told me that I'd better get out with my family because the river was higher than he'd ever seen. Two hours later the river had risen from the swamp area 20 feet behind our house,



Building Up North River Community Church wrapped its way around the garage and began to fill the garage as we loaded up a final set of couches into a neighbor's trailer. My family and I waded through the knee length, quickly moving water in the front of our house to our van to stay at this neighbor's house for the night. We left it all in the Lord's hands. The next day we discovered that there had been

Building Up North River Community Church two feet of water in both the parsonage and church.

There was a flood similar to this that happened here in 2009. Everyone thought that this was a hundred year flood. They spend a lot of time and effort to rebuild the church and parsonage then. Having this happen again 12 years later has been discouraging for God's people here in

Building Up North River Community Church the valley. This time, in addition to repairing the inside of both buildings--insulation, drywall, flooring, cabinets, we are raising up both buildings to a high enough level for future floods (3 or 4 feet). We are grateful that one builder is donating the lifting of the buildings, but we are still looking at a cost of 75,000 dollars to cover a contractor to rebuild the

Building Up North River Community Church foundations and the other repairs. We as a church are able to fund 25,000, so we are looking at a need of 50,000. In giving to this campaign, you are not only helping to build up the church and parsonage literally, but are also spiritually building up God's people here and investing in future gospel ministry in the North River Valley for the glory of Jesus Christ!

- "In the greatness of your majesty you threw down those who opposed you.
- You unleashed your burning anger; it consumed them like stubble.
- By the blast of your nostrils the waters piled up.

The surging waters stood up like a wall; the deep waters congealed in the heart of the sea.

The enemy boasted,

'I will pursue, I will overtake them.

I will divide the spoils;

I will gorge myself on them.

I will draw my sword and my hand will destroy them.' But you blew with your breath, and the sea covered them.

They sank like lead in the mighty waters.

Who among the gods is like you, Lord? Who is like you majestic in holiness, awesome in glory, working wonders?

"You stretch out your right hand, and the earth swallows your enemies. In your unfailing love you will lead

the people you have redeemed.

In your strength you will guide them to your holy dwelling.

- The nations will hear and tremble; anguish will grip the people of Philistia. The chiefs of Edom will be terrified, the leaders of Moah will be seized with
- the leaders of Moab will be seized with trembling,
- the people of Canaan will melt away; terror and dread will fall on them.

By the power of your arm they will be as still as a stone until your people pass by, Lord, until the people you bought pass by. You will bring them in and plant them on the mountain of your inheritance the place, Lord, you made for your dwelling, the sanctuary, Lord, your hands established.

When Pharaoh's horses, chariots and horsemen went into the sea, the Lord brought the waters of the sea back over them, but the Israelites walked through the sea on dry ground. Then Miriam the prophet, Aaron's sister, took a timbrel in her hand, and all the women followed her, with timbrels and dancing.

Miriam sang to them:

"Sing to the Lord,
for he is highly exalted.
Both horse and driver
he has hurled into the sea."
