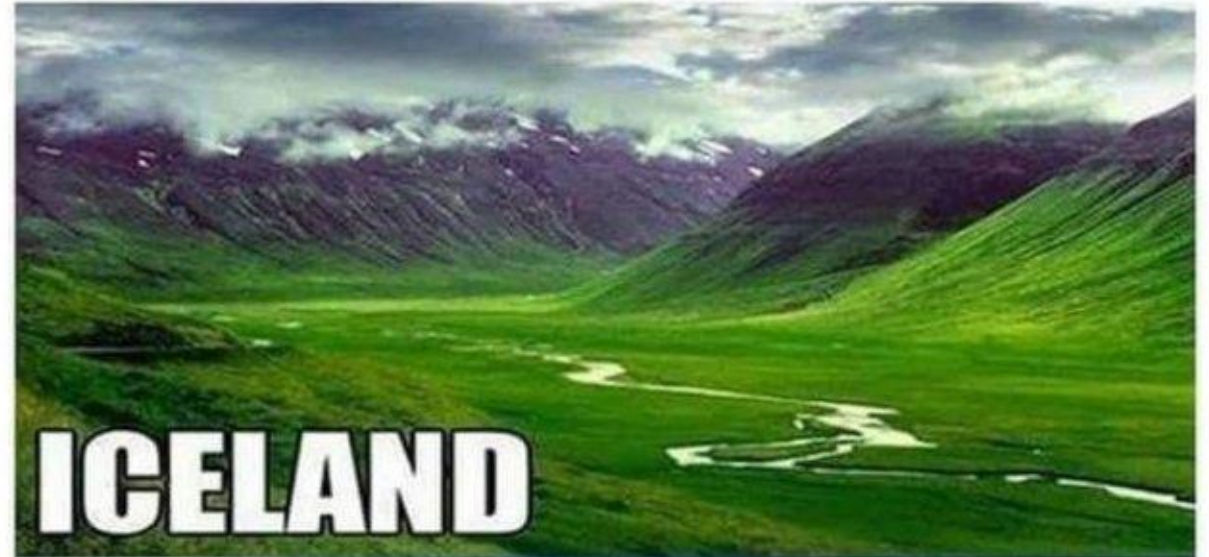
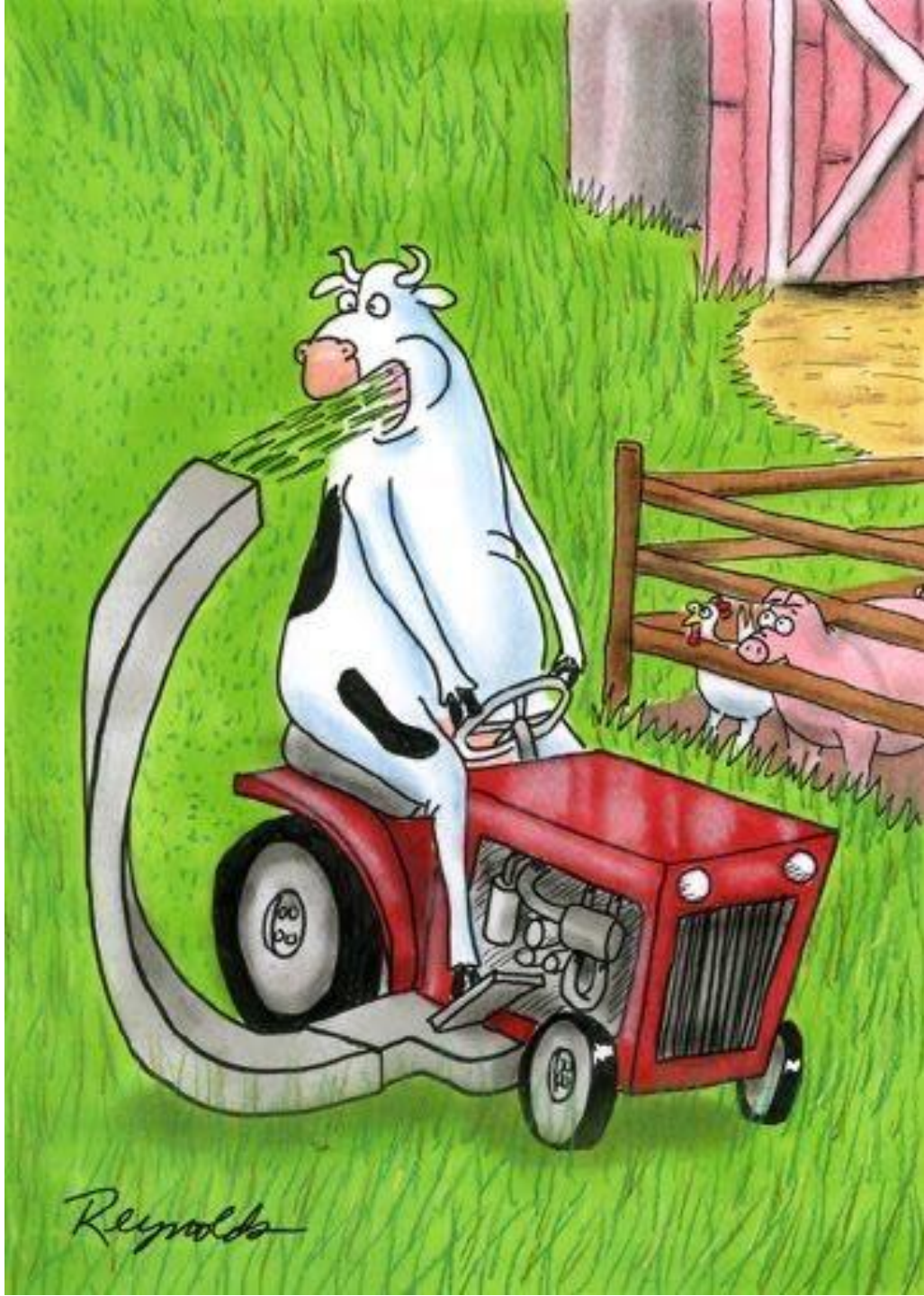

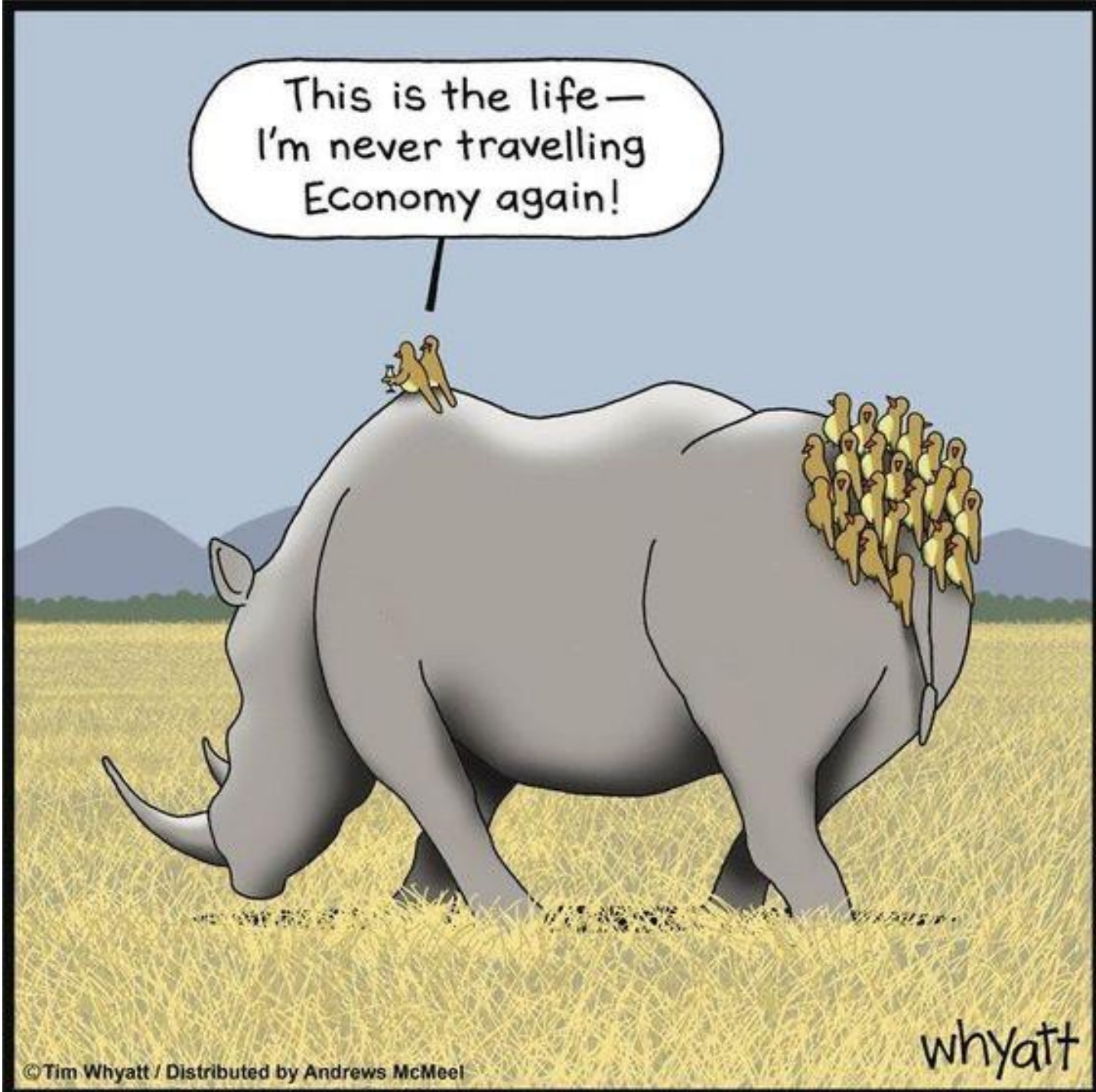
Closing Sermon Words
