



Colossians 4:2 (NASB)

Devote yourselves to prayer, keeping alert in it with an attitude of thanksgiving;

Ephesians 6:18 (NASB)

With every prayer and request, pray at all times in the Spirit, and with this in view, be alert with all perseverance and every request for all the saints,

1 Thessalonians 5:17 (NASB)

pray without ceasing,

Luke 18:1-8 (NASB)

Now He was telling them a parable to show that at all times they ought to pray *and not become discouraged,*

Isaiah 40:30-31 (NASB)

Though youths grow weary and tired,
And vigorous young men stumble badly,
Yet those who wait for the Lord
Will gain new strength;
They will mount up with wings like
eagles, They will run and not get tired,
They will walk and not become weary.

Isaiah 41:10 (NASB)

Do not fear, for I am with you;

Do not be afraid, for I am your God.

I will strengthen you, I will also help you,

I will also uphold you with My righteous
right hand.'

Deuteronomy 31:8 (NASB)
