Psalm 103 (NASB)

Bless the Lord, my soul,

And all that is within me, bless His holy name.

And do not forget any of His benefits;

Who pardons all your guilt,

Who redeems your life from the pit,

Psalm 103 (NASB)

Luke 20:19-26 (NASB)

The scribes and the chief priests tried to lay hands on Him that very hour, and yet they feared the people; for they were aware that He had spoken this parable against them.

And so they watched Him closely, and sent spies who pretended to be righteous, in order that they might catch Him in some statement, so that they could hand Him over to the jurisdiction and authority of the governor.

And the spies questioned Him, saying, “Teacher, we know that You speak and teach correctly, and You are not partial to anyone, but You teach the way of God on the basis of truth. Is it permissible for us to pay taxes to Caesar, or not?”
